

Gifts for our Nursing Home Residents

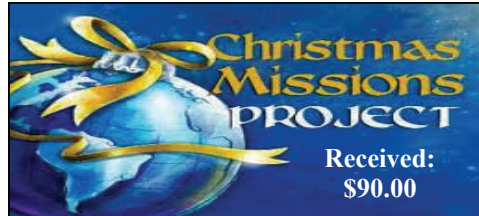
It's time to gather those gifts for our friends at the nursing home!
